Building Calgary's talent by connecting education to work experience



Calgary Work Integrated Learning (Calgary WIL) is a collaboration of 10 partners working to build Calgary's skilled talent pool by supporting employers to engage post-secondary students in relevant work experiences.

Championed by Calgary Economic Development, components of a 2022 to 2025 pilot project include the creation of a secretariate team to provide guidance and support, a digital resource platform that offers a

central portal to post student opportunities and an independent evaluation to determine future scalability and expansion.

This pilot is the largest known WIL collaboration in Canada. Pilot partners include Ambrose University, AU Arts, Bow Valley College, Mount Royal University, SAIT, St. Mary's University, the University of Calgary, the Calgary Chamber of Commerce, the Calgary Chamber of Voluntary Organizations and Calgary Economic Development.
